

DIGITAL LITERACY SKILLS FOR EVERYONE (DLS4E)

BRIDGING THE DIGITAL DIVIDE, ONE PERSON AT A TIME.

Objective:

- Implement a remote and bilingual digital literacy program to help immigrant Latinx families develop their digital literacy skills with the goal of empowering them to take full advantage of the vast online resources available to them.

Outcomes:

- Worked with Dr. Joyelle Harris, director of the Engineering for Social Innovation Center, and a team of undergraduate students on the planning, designing and development of a bilingual (English/Spanish) digital literacy course.
- Dr. Harris will share the digital literacy course with local and international organizations (i.e., Latin American Association).

Next Steps:

- Work with local organizations to provide free, remote and bilingual (English/Spanish) digital literacy classes.
