

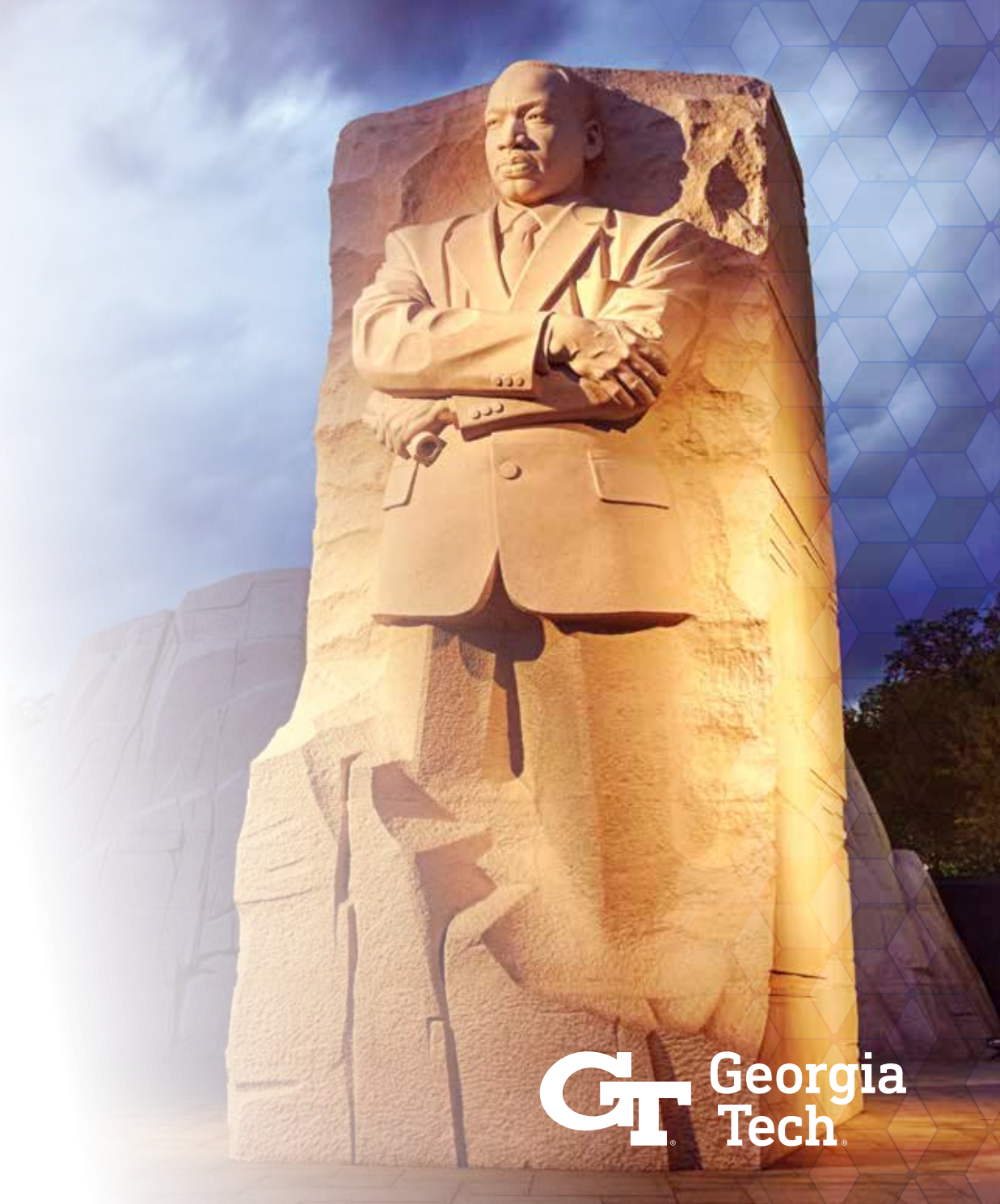
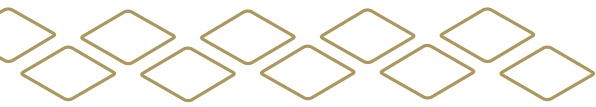

Institutions of higher education across the U.S. responded to George Floyd's murder with public statements of commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion – as well as to supporting more anti-racism work. Yet, more than a year later, it is not clear that these promises have been realized: commitments to social justice change must be accompanied by the requisite capacities and skills for leading such change.
